Don't curb RBI autonomy 

This refers to your editorial on RBI autonomy. The attempt by Finance Ministry to act as a super regulator over all regulatory bodies in the financial sector will destabilize the equilibrium deftly built up by eminent persons who headed the Finance Ministry and the RBI. The ULIP Ordinance has brought to the fore a need for the effective use of options like mutual discussion, domestic scrutiny of extant legal positions and mediation by the controlling ministry/ministries at Centre. And, about providing an opportunity to the concerned regulatory bodies to be heard before superimposing what is felt right by the North Block, which is an easy option. One wishes such disputes are resolved amicably across the table before reaching the courts and media. The ULIP episode is only a symptom and the Finance Ministry has whenever a needed asserted its 'ownership rights' over regulatory bodies, which does not augur well especially in an open market economy. In such a situation, the balance of convenience is in not disturbing the autonomy of statutory bodies like the RBI.

Meeting with Shri Deepak Singh

All the CEC delegates, led by President Shri S.V. Mahadik, attended the meeting with Shri Deepak Singhal, CGM in Charge, HRDD, at 12 noon on 31 May 2010 in the Conference room on 15th Floor of Central Office Building. Shri V. P. Arya, GM, also participated. Shri Mahadik, initiating the discussion stated that periodical updation of pension and improvements in medical facilities were the two main issues affecting the retirees. The CGM informed the members that Governor was keen for early resolution of the issue of updation. Two senior officers of the Department, S/Shri Arya and Das had gone to Delhi to try to sort out the matter with the Finance Department officials. However the meeting did not bring result and now he was of the view that only Governor and Secretary, Ministry of Finance, if they meet could sort out the issue. Bank now proposes to end of Regulation 2(2) of RBI Pension Regulations and to approach the Government in the matter. This will take time. We are presently knocking the doors. To him, Shri Singhal added, there is no deadline to get the solution and the Bank was not keen to press the issue before 2007 pay revision takes place and he is comfortable even if there is delay. However in the end updation will take place, as is the wish of the Governor, he added. On medical facilities, he stated that although the stoppage charges for the serving employees have been revised, this had not been done for the MAF members, as this would involve payment of higher premium to the insurance company. Only 2% of the hospitalization cases of the retirees cross the present ceiling. Such cases are being referred to the Central Office, which pays the balance amount. If any of the TPA is not providing satisfactory service that should be reported to the local RDs who are advised to blacklist such TPAs.

Reacting to the CGM's observations on the issue of updation, Shri R.P. Donde and Shri T.G. Nair pointed out that the Bank had earlier consulted its Legal Department and had also obtained opinion of two eminent lawyers who had unequivocally stated that the Bank was fully within its powers to update the pension of its retired employees periodically. The Bank had also filed two affidavits to that effect before the Bombay High Court. Under the circumstances this volte-face on the part of the Bank was not appropriate, legally or morally. On medical facilities, Shri Murari Chatterji explained the difficulties of the retirees. Concluding, CGM stated that a group of 4 to 5 office-bearers should meet the HRDD officers before renewal of next year's contract with the insurance company so that the problems could be sorted out.

On recognition of the Association CGM skirted the issue by stating that as many as over 40 retirees organizations are writing to the Bank creating a problem for it as to which one to be recognized. It was pointed out that out of the 40 or over organizations, 21 are units affiliated to All India Reserve Bank Retired Employees Association and many more are the units of All India Reserve Bank Retired Officers Association, almost totally consisting of pre-1986 retiree officers, all of whom are over 84/85 years of age. The Association is now defunct, as due to advanced age even the office-bearers are confined to bed and unable to call any organizational meeting for the last many years. Under the circumstances the Bank should recognise AIRBRE Association, without delay.
